

Carly coaching Jennifer transcript

Note: There must be a separate line for each time coach speaks, and client speaks. As well as a corresponding timestamp for each time coach speaks, and client speaks.

Example:

Coach (00:00): I just started the recording. Thank you Jennifer, for allowing me to record for mentoring and credentialing purposes.

Client (00:08): Thank you so much.

Coach (00:09): How are you?

Client (00:11): I'm fine. It's been, it's been a little bit of a strange situation, to be honest, to look into how the world is transforming around me, and how, what is my situation in that, in that whole constellation of things around me and the, and the impact on me, of course, on my work, how do I need to do things differently, meeting people is not, you know, establishing connection, meeting new people is not easy, but it's, of course, you could do it in different manner.

Transcript continues in same format as above.
